3. I'm a 3.2-million-pound hotel that was picked up and moved on rollers to a new location five blocks away from my original site in 1985. _____
4. I'm an annual event that kicks off the twinkling of over 100,000 lights along the Riverwalk the Friday after Thanksgiving. _____
5. I'm the organization that has hosted the city's largest annual jazz festival with regional and national talent in Travis Park since 1984. _____
6. I was envisioned by Robert H. H. Hugman and I'm a top Texas tourist destination that also serves as a flood control mechanism for the city. _____
7. We keep downtown SA beautiful and will always help with directions, restaurant recommendations. Our team in yellow is here to help. _____
8. Only during my free annual event will you see dozens of horses, cattle, sheep, dogs, and handlers walking the streets of downtown. I'm a parade that does not allow any motorized vehicles or rubber tires to participate. _____
9. I was founded in 1731 by a group of 15 families from the Canary Islands, and I'm the oldest, continuously functioning religious community in the state of Texas. _____

10. A 26-foot copper domed gazebo sits in the middle of me and I'm named after a hero of the Texas Revolution. My gazebo is also available to rent for all types of ceremonies. _____
11. Walk down my alley and you'll find an art installation that is made up of a series of photographs that were extracted from *Humans of San Antonio*. _____
12. An estimated 10,000 gallons of "Enchilada Red" paint was used to color the exterior of my building. _____
13. Originally opened in 1881 you could get two beers in exchange for a pair of antlers, or a shot of whiskey for a rattlesnake rattle. Today, I can be found on Houston Street where you can grab a bite to eat and visit our museums. _____
14. I was the first theater in the state to be fully air-conditioned and today I'm home to Broadway in San Antonio. _____
15. I'm known as being San Antonio's first neighborhood. In me you can find the Cos House, where General Cos signed articles capitulating to the Texans in 1835. _____
